<p><b><u>Kodable</u></b>  <b>App or Online</b>  <b>We use the iPad app at school</b></p>	
<p><b><u>Code.org</u></b>  <b>In Dec. we participate in the International Hour of Code</b>  <b>Kdg - 4 will be given a username and passcode to start their progress through the various courses.</b></p>	
<p><b><u>Box Island - iPad App by Radiant Games</u></b>  <b>Teaching students the fundamentals of coding - What if...</b></p>
